

RULES FOR THE 2020 TEXAS CRAWFISH FESTIVAL

1. Absolutely No Refunds or Transfers.
2. Festival Management reserves the right to decline or prohibit any Exhibit or part of an Exhibit that, in the opinion of the Festival Management is not professional or appropriate for the festival.
3. Festival Management reserves the right to refuse entry to any vendor that, in the opinion of Festival Management is not behaving in a professional or appropriate manner at the festival.
4. Booth assignments will be made by Festival Management based on application receipt time, number of booths required, type of merchandise, needs of the festival, etc. Festival Management has the right to change booth space to another available space as needed. Vendor must set up in booth space assigned and may not choose to move their booth without approval of Festival Management. This could result in vendor being removed from the festival.
5. Festival Management reserves the right to publish or reproduce any photos taken during the festival for advertising or promotional purposes.
6. Neither Erbe Foundation nor Spring Preservation League Incorporated shall be held responsible for any loss, theft, damage, or personal injury sustained on the festival site. Vendor agrees to assume full responsibility for any damages to its property and/or merchandise.
7. Festival hours are Noon to 11:00 p.m. Saturday, Noon to 6:00 p.m. Sunday. Applicants are required to stay until close. Vendor is responsible for securing booth when they leave.
8. Set up will be Friday, April 25, 2020 commencing at 8:00 a.m. All Applicants must be set up and ready for business by 11:00 a.m. Saturday. All vehicles must be removed from festival grounds by 10:00 a.m. (No Exceptions). After that time Applicant will have to carry merchandise into the festival grounds.
9. Vendor's failure to occupy assigned space by 10:00 a.m. on Saturday will be considered cancellation of the contract and vendor will forfeit any fees paid.
10. Access Sunday evening will be allowed once crowds are cleared, as determined by Security.
11. Vendor may not sublet booth space. Sharing of booth spaces is prohibited.
12. All business must be conducted within your assigned space. Vendors may not stand in aisles or walk around festival grounds to conduct their business.
13. Applicant is responsible for displays, equipment, etc.
14. Vendors will be supplied with parking placards. These can be used in the parking lots adjacent to the festival grounds operated by the Knights of Columbus. Placards will not be collected by parking attendants. If your placards are lost, stolen or left at home, you will have to pay regular parking fee.
15. Bring your own chairs and Tables. *You May Not Commandeer Festival Equipment.*
16. Anyone not wearing badge will not be granted entry to the festival unless they purchase a ticket.
17. No animals are allowed in festival grounds. This is for the safety of our attendees.
